What is the approximate size of your proposed float or group?

The optimum float size is 6'x10'. Floats should not exceed 10 feet in width. (Add-ons that are installed in the staging area and removed at the conclusion of the parade, which result in the float exceeding 10 feet in width only while on the parade route, will be accepted.) Including tow unit, floats must not exceed 50 feet in length. No entries can exceed 12 feet in height. Groups may have up to 50 people. Marching bands may have up to 125 members.:

Parade registration deadline: By Thursday, January 11, 2024, 5:00 p.m.

Monday, January 15th – Parade Day

- Nothing thrown or handed out.
- No stationary demonstrations, routines, or performances along the parade route
- No live animals unless prior approval is given from parade organizers.
- No sirens, bullhorns, fireworks, bubbles, silly string, balloons, or poppers.
- Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission staff has the final approval of all parade entries. If any entries are deemed inappropriate they will be removed from the parade.
- Participant drop-off will only be at designated locations given to your representative prior to the parade.
- Lineup for staging will take place between 10 a.m.-11:30 a.m. If you arrive after this time, you may be disqualified and removed from the parade entry list.
- We understand and agree that the Martin Luther King Jr. Commission has the right to remove any entry from the parade for any inappropriate display or behavior by any participant and agree to abide by the rules.
- I understand that all entries must be ready to go at 11:30 a.m. for a prompt start time of 12 p.m. I have marked important dates in my and my team's calendars.
- I understand that photos and video will be taken throughout the event. The MLK Commission will use these images to promote and celebrate the parade on the website, in printed materials, and social media.

Release and indemnity
